It also can be used for passes to the post players for work around the basket as well. The new one we want to purchase is easier to store (compact machine), offers an app for players to track their shooting stats and coaches to follow, can track up to 5 players at a time, 5 year warranty, minnesota company, and is a machine we would use in the winter season as the current one is so bulky and in the way we only use it in the summer.
